It acts by binding to the catalytic subunit of cAMP dependent protein kinase, but not the holoenzyme. This synthetic inhibitor has a K_I value of 2.3 nM and the inhibition has been found to be competitive with respect to the protein substrate. IP-20 has also been reported to abolish the Na:K pump effect of cAMP agonists involved in the intracellular signalling in the regulation of renal Na-K-ATPase.
