This product is supplied as a ready-to-use buffered alkaline phosphatase substrate containing 5-bromo-4-chloro-3-indolyl phosphate (BCIP®) and nitro blue tetrazolium (NBT). Prior to reaction with alkaline phosphatase, the substrate should appear as a colorless to light yellow solution. It will develop a insoluble dark purple reaction product when reacted with alkaline phosphatase on membrane applications (i.e., blotting). This substrate produces an insoluble reaction product and **is not recommended** for multiwell (e.g., ELISA) or immunohistochemical applications.

Preparation Instructions

The product is a ready-to-use, one component substrate for alkaline phosphatase and is supplied at the working dilution.

Storage/Stability

Store the product at 2-8 °C. This substrate is lightsensitive and should be protected from direct sunlight or UV sources.

Procedure

The product should be brought to room temperature (\sim 25 °C) before use. Use enough substrate solution to completely cover the membrane surface. Upon incubation, a dark purple reaction product will develop on membrane sites where alkaline phosphatase is present. The reaction should be monitored continuously and read before background color becomes too intense resulting in diminished contrast between positive and background staining. Stop the reaction by rinsing briefly with water.

Dilution of the substrate is not recommended. To reduce the intensity of a reaction, it is recommended that the antibodies or conjugates be diluted.
