Product Description

TrueGel3D Enzymatic Cell Recovery Solution (TRUEENZ) is used to dissolve the hydrogel matrix and recover cells for post culture analysis from dextran based hydrogels.

Dextranase isolated from *Chaetomium gracile* is the main constituent of TrueGel3D enzymatic cell recovery solution. It cleaves glycosidic bonds of dextran to recover both live and fixed cells without any cellular damage.

Storage/Stability

TrueGel3D Enzymatic Cell Recovery Solution may be stored at 4 $^{\circ}$ C for short term (<6 months), and at -70 $^{\circ}$ C for long term storage. Avoid frequent freeze-thaw cycles

Procedure

- Add 300 μL of TrueGel3D Enzymatic Cell Recovery Solution diluted 1:20 with cell culture supernatant to dissolve 25 μL of gel. Note: Increase rate of dissolution by cutting gels into small pieces.
- 2. Incubate at 37 °C for 30-60 minutes.
- 3. Centrifuge the cell suspension and resuspend the pelleted cells in fresh medium or buffer.
- 4. Repeat step 3 twice to remove the remaining TrueGel3D Enzymatic Cell Recovery Solution in the gel components.
- Cells are now ready to use for post culture analysis or to set up new hydrogel.
 Note: If TrueGel3D Enzymatic Cell Recovery Solution is not removed completely, it will

destabilize the newly set up hydrogel
