Present mainly in the mitochondrial compartment of peripheral tissues. PBR interacts with some benzodiazepines and has different affinities than its endogenous counterpart. PBR appears to be a key factor in the flow of cholesterol into mitochondria to permit the initiation of steroid hormone synthesis.
